How the definition of **sexual consent** has changed in Victoria

'Consent' means a free and voluntary agreement or 'permission'

A person does not consent just because they do not resist verbally or physically

A person does not consent just because they have agreed to a sexual act before

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THE DOs

HEALTHY

- **DO** continue to ask for consent to have sex, even if you've received consent to have sex with someone before.
- **DO** ask things like: Is it ok if I touch you here? Or can I please kiss you? And **DO** wait for a response.
- **DO** ask for consent before you take an intimate image or video of someone.
- **DO** make sure you find out if the other person wants you to touch them intimately.
- **DO** make sure you are both on the same page about safe sex and contraception.
- **DO** get a YES! This can be a verbal YES or shown with actions but only a YES means YES!



Remember, sexual consent in Victoria means that both parties need to give a **SUPER KEEN YES!**

THE DON'Ts

- **DON'T** assume someone likes what you are doing to them, if they haven't said NO or if they haven't resisted.
- **DON'T** start intimately touching someone who can't give consent, like when they are intoxicated or sleeping or if they are too young to give consent.
- **DON'T** share any intimate images or videos of another person without consent.
- **DON'T** pressure another person into a sexual act.
- **DON'T** assume that sex or being intimate is on, just because you've had sex before.
- And **DON'T** remove or tamper with a condom without consent.
